- Giving attention to the situation, but also the delivery of messages to and from others.
- Learning the drivers of behavior and being equipped to address them successfully.

Scott's goal is to inspire and empower audience members to use the techniques of influence and communication to skillfully address difficult conversations or interactions and achieve successful outcomes that benefit the entire organization. He demonstrates how strategically focused conversations are opportunities to connect, find common ground, and ultimate success in even the most challenging scenarios.
