For middle and high schoolers, Randi touches on more serious themes related to acceptance, inclusivity and leading with kindness, through her presentation, **Bullied and Triumphant**.

A Pittie Pool Party Children's Book Description

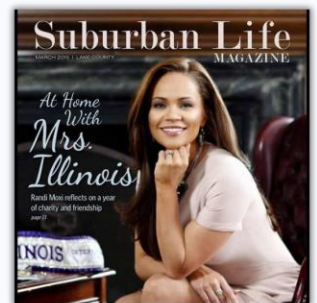
*Becca must tell her newly rescued puppy Sister some hard truths about the way people view her breed.

Bullied and Triumphant

Randi Moxi reinforces themes of individuality, kindness, gratitude, inclusivity, and positivity through her presentation for middle and high school students entitled, **Bullied and Triumphant**. She inspires and motivates young people through the sharing of personal stories about being bullied as a girl and how she was able to navigate adversity due to life and leadership skills she learned through the sport of pageantry. Through her enthusiasm and energy, Randi empowers youth to celebrate that there is no one else like them in this world, and that they can overcome challenges using power from within - their choices and superpowers.

Through recalling her own painful experiences with bullying through middle and high school, Randi shows young people these experiences can in fact be gifts of preparation - as well as opportunities to show others how important it is to be kind and inclusive, starting with themselves. She reinforces that, "spilling the light within over onto others" brings many positives to all. A final message Randi shares is that joining the masses to be cruel is not ever the way to personal success.

Randi grew up in West Virginia and spent a considerable amount of time in an animal shelter run by her grandmother. She saw first-hand how out of control the pet population is and hopes in addition to treating other human beings with respect and grace, people will treat their animals with the same kindness. This can be achieved through thoughtful communication and understanding the love and value that both people and animals can bring to all our lives. **A Pittie Pool Party** is Randi's first children's book.

When Randi shares the bullying eras of her life, she also shares something surprising to most - the "superpowers" she learned through her involvement in the sport of pageantry, where bullying isn't allowed. There she learned life skills and how to support fellow contestants with grace and kindness in competition, which is both taught and strongly encouraged. The result from this guidance taught her and other peers how to assess and process feelings - because winning and losing are intense. It also showed that true persistence in life can net gifts that help everyone grow. Randi excelled in the pageant world through her younger years and after moving to the Chicago area, was crowned Mrs. Illinois in 2014. She placed in the Top 15 in the world representing her platform, "Save Our Children," at the Mrs. International Pageant. She then went on to coach young girls who competed in pageants and was a pageant director for several years. Randi also founded her own brand strategy firm that she has now managed for more than a decade.

Randi lives in the Chicago suburbs with her loving husband and five amazing pit bull-mix fur children. She is focused on sharing her message of turning adversity around to become a strength and a gift that shows us how we should all live. She stresses respecting one another and our differences.
